

MEMBER ADMISSION PROTOCOL CHILEAN-CANADIAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

This protocol establishes the admission requirements that entities wishing to join the Chilean-Canadian Chamber of Commerce (the “Chamber”) must meet as Active or Partner Members.

The Chamber adheres to the following values:
integrity, inclusion, commitment, and respect.



ADMISSION REQUEST

Any company, corporation, organization, or association that wants to become a Member of the Chamber must complete the admission form sent by the Chamber.

They will also need to meet the following requirements:

- » Have a letter of recommendation from two companies that currently are Members of the Chamber; or any public or private organization associated to the economic relations between Chile and Canada.
- » Adhere to the Chamber's values as indicated above.
- » Accompany a declaration of interest indicating the reasons why the entity wishes to become part of the Chamber.
- » Be an entity with a well-known background and professional prestige.

The incorporation of a new Member will be informed to the Board and must have the **approval of 2/3 of the Directors of the Chamber.**

The Chamber's Board of Directors **reserves the right to accept applicant companies** even if it deems that any of the previously detailed requirements are not met.



TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP

The Chamber reserves the right to unilaterally terminate the membership of a partner company if such entity:

- » Does not pay their respective ordinary social contribution for two periods in a row.
- » Fails to comply with or violates the Chamber's values to which it adheres.
- » Incurs in any action, act, or omission that may give rise to a reputational risk for the Chamber.
